DAY ONE

- 2 Travel a few short minutes to **Historic Olde Towne Bellevue**. Guests can visit the Sarpy County Museum or the oldest pioneer religious structure in Nebraska, the First Presbyterian Church. Local celebrity Darrel Draper can meet guests dressed as Peter Sarpy, French fur trader and founder of Sarpy County. He will entertain and educate in a humorous and interactive presentation about the area.

Make a quick stop to freshen up and check into one of Sarpy County's fine hotels, many of which include indoor swimming pools and other amenities. The Sarpy County Tourism Office can help you choose the hotel that is right for your group.
- 3 At **Soaring Wings Vineyard & Brewery**, guests will be treated to a tour and wine/beer tasting, followed by a catered dinner and entertainment by the Sarpy Serenaders, a barbershop chorus that will make any crowd laugh, blush and sing along!
